Emergency service in the small animal clinic during externship

The assistance in the emergency service of the small animal clinic is mandatory for every person performing an externship. It is possible to sign up for voluntary shifts in addition to the required duties, especially for weekend shifts where case load tends to be high and varied.

Required emergency shifts:

One night per week (2 persons per shift)

Two weekend shifts for every 2 week rotation

Shift times:

Weekdays: a) 18.00 to 01.00 o'clock b) 01.00 to 08.00 o'clock (on-call service)

Weekend: a) 08.00 to 18.00 o'clock b) 18.00 to 01.00 o'clock c) 01.00 to 08.00 o'clock (on-call service)

Meeting point:

In the ICU

Accommodation:

An overnight shift room with beds is available; please bring your own sleeping bag!

Microwaves, fridge, cooking facilities are available in the break room.

Equipment:

Clinic scrubs are available in the hospital. Personal clothes are not allowed to be worn.

Stethoscope, thermometer, writing materials, etc need to be brought by the student.

Duties:

Students are expected to assist with the care of hospitalized patients in ICU and in the wards until the end of the midnight rounds. This includes but is not limited to: vitals check, medication administration, cleaning if necessary, feeding, other monitoring. In addition, students are expected to assist with emergency cases and patients undergoing emergency surgery.
